**Under this agreement for 2017
Peregian Springs State School will receive**

\$303,095*

This funding will be used to


- Lift the average scale score of all assessed NAPLAN students to above the Australian Mean scores in Years 3 and 5
- Lift the proportion of NAPLAN students assessed as having achieved in the upper two bands in more than two thirds of areas to >45% for Year 3 and > 35% for Year 5
- Lift the average relative gain of assessed NAPLAN students when compared to 2015 to 2017 and 2014 to 2016 for Years 3 and 5
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN Upper Two Bands in writing to be exceeding Australian U2B scores in Years 3 and 5
- Maintain between 97-100% of students achieving beyond the NMS for Year 3 and 5 in the NAPLAN Reading, Writing and Number in Years 3 and 5

Our initiatives include

- Continue to implement a whole school monitoring process for all students below the NMS in Years 1 to 6, and for all students at risk of dropping below the NMS in Years 1-5 by the end of Term 1
- Implement an intensive PD program for teachers new to the school in school programs
- Implement quality PD for all teachers in differentiation, inquiry learning and catering for diverse learning needs
- Improve teacher capability through focused coaching in the teaching of reading, writing and number sense
- Continue intensive professional development in the teaching of reading, writing, number sense and digital literacy for all teachers with particular emphasis via the Master Teacher for Prep to Year 2 and Year 4 and 5

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Increasing the STLN allocation by 1 FTE	\$100 000
• Increasing the Teacher Aide support in Years 1 and restructuring how it is allocated	\$145 000
• Providing all Teacher Aides with intensive school-based PD to assist them in their roles	\$2 000
• Providing professional development to new teachers and teachers being trained as coaches	\$15 000
• Providing professional development in differentiation and inquiry for all classroom teachers	\$21 095
• Providing release time for teacher collaboration, class teacher exchanges and coaching opportunities in reading, writing and number sense	\$20 000
