Under this agreement for 2018
Peregrin Springs state School will receive

\$303,095*

This funding will be used to

- Maintain average mean scale scores of students sitting NAPLAN to be above national mean scores in all areas
- Lift the percentage of students achieving national mean scores in Year 3 NAPLAN Spelling to above national mean scale scores
- Lift the proportion of students assessed as having achieved in the upper 2 bands (U2B) in more than two thirds of areas to >45% for Year 3 and >35% for Year 5
- Maintain between 97%-100% of students exceeding National Minimum Standard for Year 3 and 5 in all five areas of NAPLAN
- Lift the average relative gain of students sitting NAPLAN when compared to 2016-2018 and 2015-2017 for Year 3 and 5
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN U2B in Writing to exceed National U2B scores in Year 3 and 5

Our initiatives include

- Continue to implement and expand Inquiry cycles for all year level teams, to build capacity of teaching staff and embed inquiry and collaboration as an organisational routine of school-wide professional learning and development
- Continue to implement a whole school monitoring process identifying students that are 'high achievement/low gain' in each year level
- Continue to implement a whole school monitoring process for all students
- Implement an intensive Professional Development (PD) program for new teaching staff where applicable
- Implement quality, targeted PD programs that align with school priorities in differentiation and diverse learning
- Improve teacher capability through focused coaching in the teaching of reading, writing and number sense

Increase of teacher Full Time Equivalent to support release time for teachers to engage in inquiry into pedagogy and outcomes	\$100 000
Maintaining the Teacher Aide support in lower school for students below year level benchmarks	\$145 000
Advanced Week in Choice Theory for 16 staff	\$17 000
Train and release teachers for peer coaching	\$19 000
Provide professional development in differentiation and inquiry for all classroom teachers	\$20 000
Provide all Teacher Aides with intensive school-based PD to assist them in their roles	\$2095
