Added attention to the problem by community members and promotion of Green Zone and its use has been improved by this initiative.</p> <p>No volunteers are able to man the zone on a regular basis and school is unable to spare staff for the role.</p> <p>Discussion about closure of green Zone by Council following absence of volunteers and inability of parents to follow Green Zone instructions. Possible impact on parking and traffic resulting from this was discussed.</p>	Dave Williams
